Beechworth Historic Town/Photography Tour

Meet: Front of the Beechworth Visitor Information Centre, Town Hall 103 Ford Street, Beechworth.

What to bring: Your camera, rolls of film or memory cards and tripod.

Lunch: BBQ lunch (included in cost) by Lake Sambell
Tour guide Pat Doyle will drive us around Beechworth on his 24 seater mini bus, giving 2 hours guided commentary on Historic Beechworth.

Tour sites include: The Chinese Burning towers at Beechworth Cemetery, May Day Hills (The old Asylum centre - now La Trobe at Beechworth) the Ha Ha Fence, where gold was discovered in 1852, The Government administration buildings (Historic Courthouse, Sub Treasury building etc), The Ovens District Hospital facade (which was the only hospital between Melbourne and Goulburn back in the gold rush days) Woolshed falls and much more...
