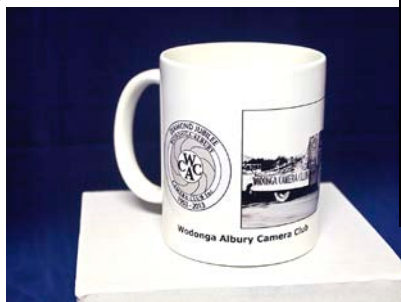
Pics have to be submitted to Albury City by May 27th, so the time frame is fairly short.
