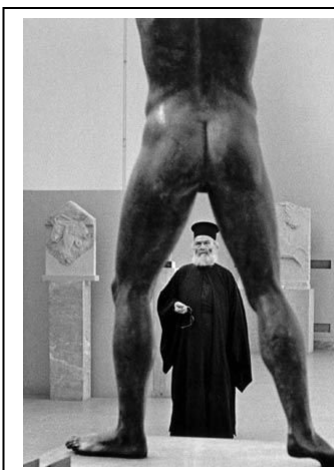
I believe that negotiations are under way with the North Albury Sports Club re the club meeting there into the future. More on this at tonight's meeting.
