The patch of light highlighting the dust and ute kept the judge's eye on the subject of the image whilst the foreground and background set the rural scene. Overall, the judge thought that Debbie's image told a great story about farming in Australia and evoked a feeling of rural life.

The cost is \$12 + GST per garment.


The details of the Company we are using is "Border Embroidery & Corporate "located in the "SafePak" building at 75 Catherine Cres, Lavington NSW 2641.
