

Any Club, over the years, has the potential of becoming stagnant. It may be because the same people are elected year after year or the same ideas and formats re-hashed. Whatever the reason it is not unique to any Club.

Here are some guidelines to assist Members in making the right choice when electing a -

- President
- Vice President/s
- Secretary
- Vice Secretary/s
- Treasurer, supporting Treasurer/s
- Committee Members General
- Sub Committees Competition Secretary, Social Committee, Newsletter Editor, Buddy System Co-ordinator, Facebook Administrator, Website Administrator

Do not make the mistake of electing people because they have been in the Club for a long time or you would feel sorry for them if they were not (re) elected.

Do make your selection based on how you see them as a leader, a speaker, a contributor, a person who is not afraid to take control of a Monthly Meeting or Committee Meeting and lead everyone in a welcoming, photography and camera informative and inclusive way.

Do encourage someone you feel has the experience and capability to fill a position on the Committee be it in leadership or behind the scene. *(continued...)*

Members need to know who the potential next elected persons are and what they intend to do for the Club.

Suggested: That a self-written synopsis by the person standing for a position, be emailed to all members so that they (the Members), in their own mind, come up with good reasoning for electing that person to that position. The synopsis should also be available at the beginning of the AGM for those who do not use email.

Suggested: At the AGM all those standing for a position should be formally made known to Members and a very short *self-introduction* with the reason why they are standing, plus why they would be best suited for that position.

Of course, there are many positions within the Committee that Members may feel more comfortable with. Talk with a current Committee Member to find out more about these positions and how you can assist, behind the scenes. This will make WACC a more photography and camera informative, helpful and welcoming Club. A place where you look forward to being involved.
