Lightroom Tip of the Day:

Watermarks. LR has the best batch watermarking functions, as long as you don't care where the watermark is placed.

Watermarks are added when you export your images from LR. (File --> Export). Watermarks are created when you go to Lightroom (Edit on a PC) ---> Edit Watermarks.

Create to your heart's content! Not to get into the subject of whether to watermark or NOT, I like the idea of creating a very translucent watermark that is placed in the centre of your image. Not enough to distract, to enough you can see it's there.

Alternatively, I also like watermarking for branding purposes and placing it solidly and visibly in the corner of my images. How about you?
