Good job separating the subject from the back ground. Black back ground works well. Not enough of the subject is in focus. Higher f-stop required or focus stack.

Good use of longer shutter, good exposure, the dark rocks often cause over exposure, watch your white balance, there is a yellowish tinge suggesting white balance is too high. The grass in the bottom right is ok but the one in the bottom left is too distracting.

Like your choice of subject, all of it is nice and sharp. Your composition has let you down, the left and the top of the subject are cropped off and there is too much of the table at the bottom. If you try this again move the subject further away from the background.

Good capture of the bird in the action of feeding. Two elements need attention, the exposure is too bright, we lose a lot of detail in the bird, (the highlight slider in Lightroom may help) There is very little sharpness, especially on the bird.

What we have to do is expose for the sky which will make the tree very dark, but in Lightroom we can retrieve all that detail and make the tree stand out much more. Use Select Subject in the masking tools (this will select the tree) and most of the hard work is done for you, then you just bring up the exposure and shadows on the tree without brightening up the background.

Because Bin chickens can be found in most places, they are like Seagulls and Pelicans, they make great training subjects for photographers. You have good detail on the bird but he's not doing anything. Now you know you have the framing and focus sorted it's time to go out and capture one of these birds in the act of foraging, which we see all the time. You look around and find a place where they gather on mass (often a tip) and the rest is easy.

Pub has lots of character and the night shot works very well. Your toning is good with black to white. The building is leaning to the left and the uprights could easily be straightened, (single click of a button in Lightroom.) The tower on the top needs a touch more room above it.

The highlights from the lights on the side of the bridge have let you down a touch. Would have been better taking several frames at different exposures and blending.

Pretty little scene. Good composition with the river coming from all the way at the back of the image and exiting in the bottom right, takes our eye right through. You've used 10th of a second shutter speed which is a bit in between, not fast enough to capture any splashes and not slow enough to soften the water. I would have picked one or the other.									
18 148 The Wheel House	12	pts	Place						
The mono works very well here. The white of the bird dropping on the jetty gives us strong interest. The boat shed has lots of character and the old hand rail fits perfectly with the boat shed. Both the hand rail and the jetty lead us into the boat shed. I would like the handrail to be a bit dulled down, it's a touch too bright. The scene lends itself to a portrait composition, as the water on the right doesn't offer too much to the scene. Try cropping the right heavily and a touch off the left, it balances the image up and gives more presence to the shed.									
19 202 Work Boots with Friends	11	pts	Place						
Great idea, not sure how you've done this as the shadow doesn't look to be coming from the boots, still like the idea either way. Please be mindful of your exposure, the boots a bit over exposed and the background where the show is too bright. Even in mono we still need some detail in the whites.
