| 1 | Treat Please | | A lovely capture of this pet. Great detail in the dog. The light and shade nicely sculpt the image giving dimension. The background is non-distracting. | 7 | Macaw | 12495 | A very nice close-up of the bird's eye. It is very sharp displaying good detail. Feel the image is a little too tightly cropped. It would be good to see a little more of the bird's head to add context and meaning. The triangular perspective works very well. | 8 | Flying Downwind Catch | 12355 | A good action shot capture. Image displays good detail throughout. Feel the angle is not the best for this image. The viewer tends to look at the image rather than be engaged with the action. Maybe consider taking more head-on. The beach adds a nice context to the photo. Nicely taken. | 11 | | |
| 9 | Walking the dog | 12279 | An interesting capture of dog and master! There is some good action demonstrated in the dog's gait. Feel the focus of the image is on the rider due to the white tee-shirt. Also, feel the background is rather busy. The dark colour of the animal causes it to get somewhat lost in the image. The DoF has been well handled throwing the background out of focus. Feel rotating the image to square up the image would minimise the slanted perspective. | 12 | Even Horses Get a Cold | 12533 | A close-up of this horse's nose! There is good detail in the image. The background is nicely blurred. Feel the crop is a little tight, maybe include all of the whiskers. The shadows could do with a little lightening, also, toning down the brightness in the lower portion of the image would remove this distraction. Quite well seen and captured. | 10 | | |

| 1 | The Last Yak | 12508 | An interesting photo of this animal. There is an even tonality across the image. Feel the Yak blends in with a rather busy background. There is a hint of movement with the raised hoof. Consider masking and darkening the background and giving the animla a little more contrast and texture to make it "Pop". This would strengthen the image overall. Nicely seen by the author. | 10 | | |
| 2 | The grass is greener | 12505 | A pleasant capture of this animal. The square crop works well. The bright areas in the background are a little distracting and could help the image with a little toning down. More background blur would help removing ancillary distractions as would the removal of the fence in the foreground. Overall, an interesting image, taken with an unusual profile of the horse. | 10 | | |
| 3 | Jack | 12495 | Quite a good image of the dog. There is good contact with the viewer. Feel the animal tends to blend in with the background. Maybe consider darkening the background a little to ensure the dog is prominent. The image appears a little flat and would benefit from some additional contrast and texture. | 4 | Two cute for words | 12355 | An interesting image of these pets. The dogs are nicely prominent in the image. The background is nicely muted and the white border enhances the image.
