GENERAL COMPETITION RULES

1. Entries will be accepted from current financial members only.
2. Members may enter any or all eligible sections with a maximum of two entries per section.
3. Each entry is to be marked with an image title and member's competition number - not name. EDI files named with image title and member number separated with a tilde (~) (e.g. *The Windmill~98.jpg*)
4. EDI entries must be in JPEG format only, a maximum of 1024 pixels width and 768 pixels height.
5. Members are to avoid entering the same image more than once in the same month (*Colour, B&W or EDI*).
6. Maximum size for a print entry is 30x40cm (x0.5), including the mount.
7. All images must be the work of the entrant, entries preferably no more than 5 years old.
8. Monochrome images may have an overall tone/colour added to the processed image.
9. An entry may be resubmitted once (*second judge may offer a different comment*).
10. Competition Secretary reserves the right to refuse any entry that is deemed not to meet the Set Subject criteria or is deemed inappropriate.
11. All entries shall be submitted to the Competition Secretary at Club meetings two months before the entered competition.
