## CLUB INFORMATION

**General Meetings:** Entries from monthly competitions are viewed along with judge's comments and scores. A member, guest or visiting judge may give a print or electronic presentation on any theme. Members are given time to socialise, view competition prints and share knowledge and expertise.

**Club Competitions:** One of the best ways to develop as a photographer is to participate in competitions. By entering in competitions you can compare your efforts against fellow members to sharpen your skills and learn how to take better pictures. With that objective in mind, our Club runs monthly competitions which are presented at club meetings with judge's comments. Experiencing other photographer's work and judge's comments will inspire and challenge you.

Members participate in competitions organised by the Victorian Association of Photographic Societies (VAPS). Members are also encouraged to enter other competitions promoted through the club.

**Workshop/Outings:** Based on requests of members, workshops and outings are organised for members to enjoy and socialise, learn from visiting tutors and other experienced members.

**Annual General Meeting:** Is held at 7:30pm prior to the November general meeting.

## GENERAL COMPETITION RULES

1. Entries from current financial members only.
2. Members may enter a maximum of three images each month. One in each section.
3. **Image Naming Convention:** Each entry is to be marked with **member number** (*not name*) a tilde (~) **Image title** followed by another tilde (~) and **competition description**.
  - 98~The Willow Tree~CPA\* or (CP) for Colour Print
  - 98~The Old Barn Door~M for Monochrome
  - 98~The Windmill~EDIA\* or (EDI).jpg for EDI
  - 98~After The Storm~AV (Audio/Visual)
  - 98~Water~CP (Photographic Challenge)

\* A = Advance Photographers
4. An Audio/Visual (AV) competition will be held each year.
5. EDI entries must be in JPEG format, a max **width** of **1920 pixels** and max **height** of **1080 pixels @ 72 PPI resolution**.
6. **Do not** enter the same image in different sections.

7. Maximum size for a print entry is **30x40cm** (*including the mount*). Thickness must not exceed **3mm**.

8. All images must be the work of the entrant, including all parts of manipulated/composite images. (*Entries preferably no more than 5 years old*)

9. Monochrome images may have an overall tone/colour added to the processed image.

10. An entry that has not won a 1st or 2nd place, may be resubmitted once (*second judge may offer a different comment*). (*The Image of the Year competition is the only exception!*) The **title** must **not** be **changed** when **re-entering**.

11. Competition Secretary reserves the right to refuse any entry that is deemed not to meet the Set Subject criteria or is deemed inappropriate.

12. All entries shall be submitted to the Competition Secretary at Club meetings two months before the entered competition.

NOTE: Outings and workshops will be arranged throughout the year. Members will be advised in the club newsletter, or the club website and at club meetings.
