The matt cutter is free for members to use, but a \$20, refundable deposit is required. Members who have already paid to use this can have their money refunded.

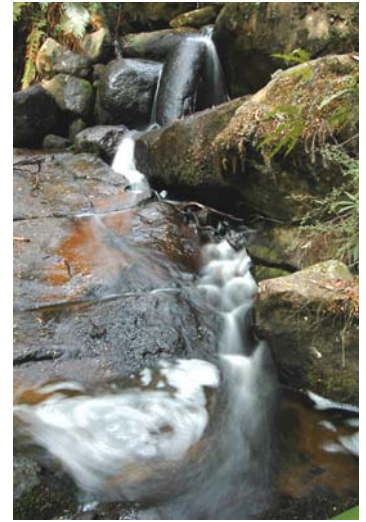

The NEGV is trailing a digital section for 2008. This will be non-competitive but images will be commented on by judges.

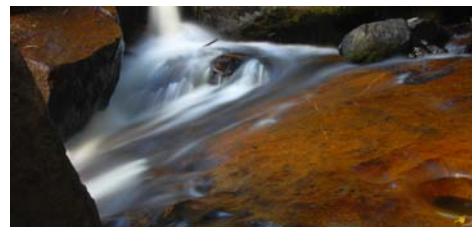
