We have two techniques of creative photography for January, hence two definitions. Have a read and decide which one you will enter.

**Abstract:** Sometimes called non-objective, experimental, conceptual or concrete photography, is a means of depicting a visual image that does not have an immediate association with the object world and has been created through the use of photographic equipment, processes or materials. An abstract photograph may isolate a fragment of a natural scene in order to remove its inherent context from the viewer, it may be purposely staged to create a seemingly unreal appearance from real objects, or it may involve the use of colour, light, shadow, texture, shape and/or form to convey a feeling, sensation or impression.

**ICM:** Intentional Camera Movement. A technique that combines the use of a slow shutter speed and intentional movement of the camera. Moving your camera while it's exposing an image means that the elements within the frame won't be frozen in place. Instead, they lose their natural appearance and start floating around the frame, giving a painterly effect. The longer the shutter speed is, the more obscure the elements become. In camera Multiple Exposure may be used, or post processing, blending multiple images may be used. The final image will be entirely up to your imagination. It may involve the use of colour, light, shadow, texture, shape and/or form to convey a feeling, sensation or impression. It may have some literal component or be completely abstract.
