

Triptych Definition & Guidelines

Definition:

A triptych is an image made up of **three** distinctly separated photographic images displayed on one background.

Guidelines:

- Should communicate a common theme.
- The background should complement the presentation of the three images but must not become a “fourth image”.
- The only restriction on the arrangement of the triptych’s three images is that they must not meet or overlap.
- There is no requirement for the three images to be the same size or the same shape.
- Added borders, drop shadows etc. are allowed.

Below are some examples of EDI of triptych images.
