

Preparing EDI Images - with Photoshop for WACC Competitions



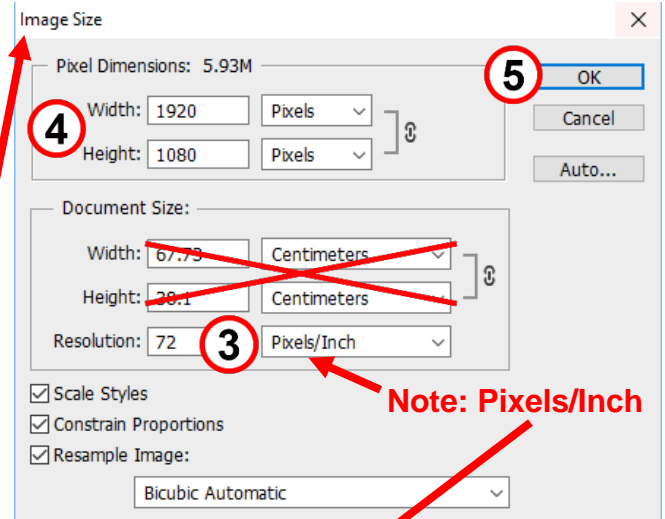
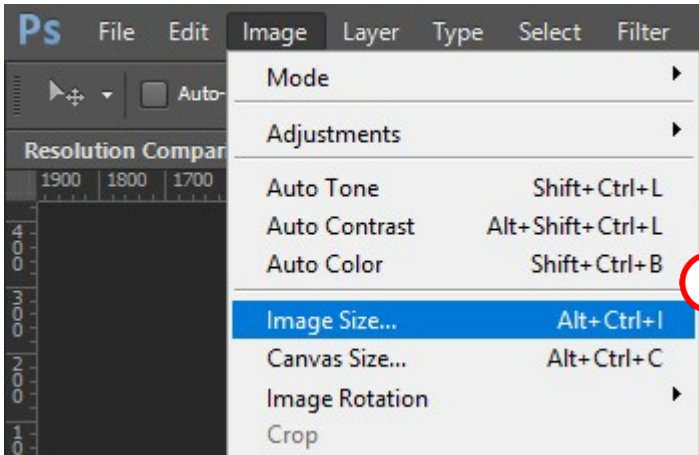
Before you start

Remember your best to be working on a **copy NOT** your **original**.

...So you have finished working on your image and **saved** it as a PSD, TIFF or JPEG etc.

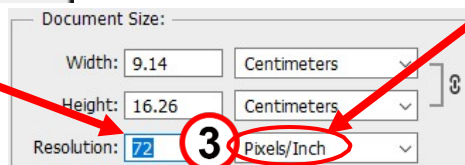
1. Crop the image

2. Select Image Size from the Image menu



3. Enter 300 PPI in the Resolution box

Ensure you have **Pixels/Inch** selected



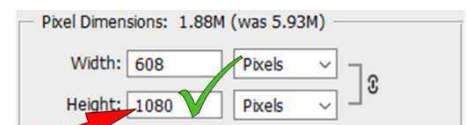
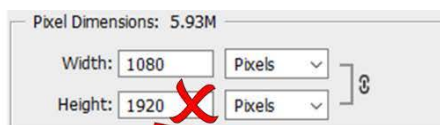
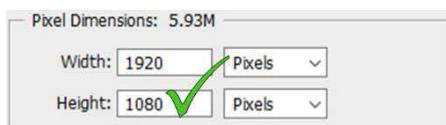
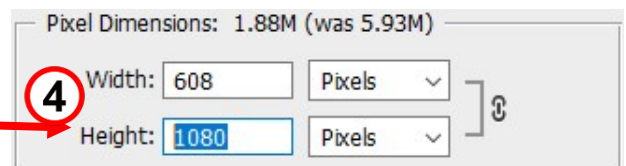
4. Resize the image... carefully. Pixel Dimensions

For **Portrait** orientation

Height - Enter **1080**

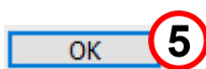
For **Landscape** orientation

Width - Enter **1920**, CHECK that the height is less than **1080** if not Enter **1080** for Height and leave the Width as is.



X Height needs to be 1080 or less, correct by entering a height of 1080

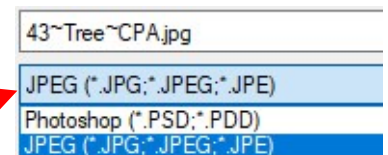
5. Press OK



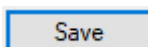
6. Now select Save As from the File menu and save as jpg file.

WACC: Image Title = Member No.~Title~Competition e.g. 43~Tree~EDIA.jpg

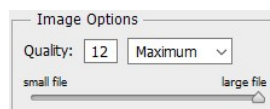
